Mrs. Adriana Gloria Walman, age 65, of Newnan, Georgia passed away peacefully in her sleep late Saturday, July 13th, 2024 in her home surrounded by her loving family. 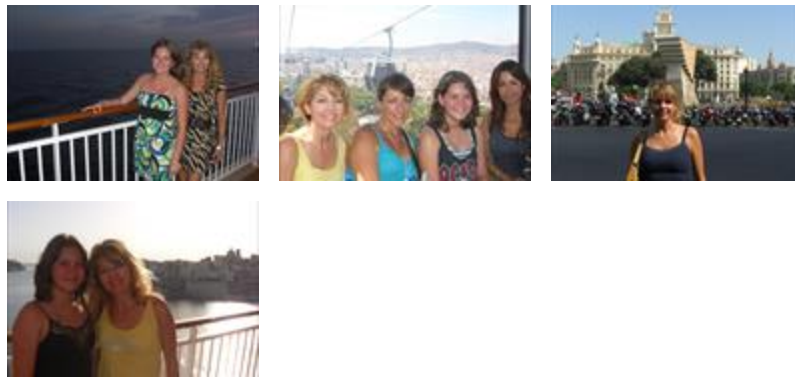
