



## Alan Lee Marchman

May 10, 1930 - April 8, 2015

Retired United States Air Force Master Sergeant Alan Lee Marchman passed away peacefully April 8, 2015 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born in Carroll County, Georgia on May 20, 1930 to Homer Lee Marchman and Effie Elkins Marchman. He enlisted in the U.S. Army Air Corps August 12, 1946. He was a flight engineer logging over 8,000 hours in transport aircraft. In December of 1956, he was the flight engineer on the first C-130 delivered from Lockheed in Marietta, Georgia to the U.S. Tactical Air Command 774th Troop Carrier Squadron based in Ardmore, Oklahoma. He flew over 500 combat sorties in Vietnam in support of U.S. forces. He retired in 1967 with over 21 years service, subsequently working as a civilian employee with the U.S. Navy until 1989. Later that year he was hired by Eastern Air Lines in Atlanta as an aircraft mechanic, and worked there until the airline shut down in 1991.

He was predeceased by his parents; wife Nora Flynn Marchman; and brothers Homer Oneal Marchman of Newnan, Georgia and Roland Marchman of Seabrook, New Hampshire. He is survived by his son Patrick Marchman of East Lansing, Michigan and daughter Sharon Marchman Granger of Raleigh, North Carolina; brothers Darrell Marchman of Moreland, Georgia, Jimmy Marchman of Newnan, Georgia, Joel Marchman of Luthersville, Georgia, Ricky Marchman of Newnan, Georgia, Steven Marchman of Villa Rica, Georgia; sister Jennie Marchman Sanders of Moreland, Georgia; four grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

The funeral service is Saturday, April 11 at 2 PM in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with visitation from 12 PM until service time on Saturday. Burial will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Park with full military honors to be rendered at the cemetery.
