It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Albert Thomas Secor, III, who left us on May 25, 2026, at the age of 47. Born on June 14, 1978, in Washington, North Carolina, Albert made his way to Newnan, Georgia, a few years after high school, where he called home.

Known by friends and family as "Al," he had a love for music and a passion for helping others. He played football for the Washington Pam Pack during high school and was also in the Washington Pam Pack Band, named after the Pamlico River. Al also played in the Tarheel Sun Drum and Bugle Choir.
