August 5, 1921 - February 8, 2021

Aldine Freeman Askew, 99, of Daphne, Alabama, formerly of Newnan, Georgia passed away on February 8, 2021 surrounded by her family. She was born in Sycamore, Georgia to Alvin Burdette Freeman and Mabel Royal Freeman.
