Mr. Alec James Bolotin, 85, of Newnan, GA died Tuesday, June 23, 2009. He was born May 5, 1924 in San Francisco, CA to the late James & Anna Buschnoff Bolotin. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his first wife of 49 years, Hope Chernoff Bolotin; children, Faith Rooney, Alec James Bolotin, Jr, Dolores Chico; and infant son, William Bolotin.
