Alice Upshaw Burgess, 83, passed away at her home in Moreland on Friday, March 15, 2024 surrounded by her family and friends. She was born in Newnan, Georgia on April 22, 1940 to the late Eugene and Claudis Upshaw, Sr. of Newnan. Alice spent most of her time in Coweta County; however, she lived and worked in Atlanta for a short time before she returned to Newnan and moved to the Moreland Community. After she graduated in 1958 from Newnan High School, she attended Massey Business School. On December 31, 1959, Alice married the love of her life, the late Billy J. Burgess, whom she met at the skating rink in LaGrange, GA. They were married for 54 years.

Alice loved helping others and shared her beautiful smile and kind, encouraging words with everyone. Christian songs which they sing to their children today. She utilized her excellent computer skills at her church where she prepared the Weekly Church Bulletin and flyers. Also, she enjoyed making cards for her family and friends with pictures from cherished memories. She was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother and loved spending time with her family on numerous vacations, get togethers and celebrations.

She was preceded in death by her husband Billy J. Burgess, parents Eugene and Claudis Upshaw, Sr., brother Joel (Connie) Upshaw and sister Rose McMichael.
