Ann Templeton Preston, 85, of Newnan died Thursday, October 8, 2009 at Southland Nursing Home in Peachtree City. She was born October 14, 1923 in Pana, Illinois, the only daughter of the late Mr. & Mrs. Edward J. Templeton. She grew up and had a successful early career with Sears & Roebuck. She moved to the Atlanta area in 1956 and to Newnan in 1977. She played an active role in her community and church. She was past president of the Newnan-Coweta Art Association, past president of the Coweta Republican Women's Club, member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, Pilgrim John Howland Society, and the Newnan-Coweta Historical Society.
