



## Ann "Angie" Elizabeth Kirby

April 3, 1921 - March 23, 2015

Ann "Angie" Elizabeth Bradley Kirby, age 93 of Sharpsburg, passed away Monday, March 23, 2015 at her home after a long illness and stroke.

She was born April 3, 1921 near Winder, Georgia. Ann was the second youngest and last survivor of ten siblings born to the late Elijah Marian Bradley and Susie Elizabeth Etheridge. Ann grew up on their farm. In 1939, she moved to LaGrange, Georgia to live with a sister. There, she met and married Gay Bolden Kirby, on December 7, 1940 until his passing in 1995. They were employed by Callaway Mills Company. She was preceded in death by her daughter, Wanda Lynn Kirby Prince.

Survivors include sons, Wyatt Bradley Kirby and Bobby Gay Kirby; five grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Ann was active in United Methodist Women, supporting community war efforts, civil patrol, church, schools, Scouts, local music bands, sports, and other organizations. She and Gay received awards from the Red Cross and Boy Scouts.

Ann was a consummate mother and homemaker. She loved good food and socializing, going to movies and church activities. She always had a wonderful smile that could light up a room. She was also highly skilled at sewing and embroidery, her favorite hobbies. She lived in Delmar Gardens, Smyrna, GA from 1995 to 2011.
