It is with heavy hearts we announce the passing of Anthony James (Tony) Marino, Jr., age 79. He was surrounded by his loving wife Sandy, of 53 years, and his family. Tony was a man of immense humor, wisdom, love, and kindness who cherished every moment he spent with his family. He was deeply loved by all who met him.

Anthony was born in West New York, N.J. to Anthony James Sr. and Catherine Marino, He was the second youngest son of their 5 sons. The Marino family moved to Ridgefield Park, NJ. Tony attended Ridgefield Park HS and Cliffside Park HS where he graduated in 1962, He attended Bloomfield College majoring in computer science.

His early accomplishments include software engineer at I.B.M, production manager at DataScope in Paramus, New Jersey. He was recruited as the Vice President of Manufacturing at Healthdyne in Marietta, Georgia. Later Tony, aka Georgia Tony was the founder and CEO of The Nutrinet Corporation, a nationwide food service software company. He operated Nutrinet for 20 years prior to retirement.

In 1968 he was drafted to the Army to serve in Vietnam. He was discharged in 1969, receiving the Purple Heart for his heroic service. Due to Agent Orange, Tony courageously battled Parkinson's Disease and PTSD for many years.

Upon returning to Fort Benning, GA he met the love of his life, a Barber at the Officer's Club, Sandy Moon. It was the best crew cut he ever received. He was back the next day for another "haircut" and a date.

Anthony was predeceased by his parents, brothers Phillip, John, and Frank. He is survived by his wife, Sandy, his son, Shannon (Sundi), daughter, Deana (Tim) Young, brother, Vincent (Jo Ann) sister-in-laws Sib Marino, Wannie (Richard) Moon Payne, brother in law Dayna (Gloria) Moon, grandchildren Nicholas Marino, Chris (Jennifer) Marino, Sofia Young, Starling Marino, and great granddaughter, Leann Marino, many nieces and nephews.
