Tony loved his Lord and served and shared that love throughout his life. Tony enjoyed helping his wife, Kenna, with the care of many foster dogs that showed him love and appreciation through the years.

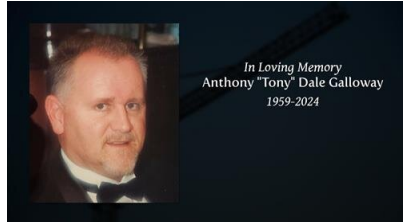
