



## Arnold Carter Dickinson

June 14, 1937 - January 19, 2012

Arnold C. Dickinson, 74, of Newnan died Thursday, January 19, 2012 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born June 14, 1937 in Monongahela, PA to the late George & Lillian Carter Dickinson.
