Aubrey Jackson "Jack" Selby passed away on Tuesday, August 11, 2009 after a short battle with cancer. Jack was born on December 5, 1934 in Newport News, VA to Aubrey Jeter Selby and Mary Swindell Selby Shavender. Jack grew up in Newport News and graduated from Newport News High School in 1952. He began his career as an electrical apprentice with Smith & Keene Electrical contractor in Newport News and later moved to Jonesboro, GA to head up their operations there. He eventually opened his own electrical company and after retiring from his business he went to work for DeKalb County as their chief electrical Inspector. He served in the Army at Fort Bliss Missile Base in El Paso, TX as a Nike Missile Instructor for three years. Jack was a member of Cokes Chapel United Methodist Church in Sharpsburg, GA.
