Barbara Carver Fagan, age 85, formerly of East Point, GA, and of Newnan, GA, passed away on Sunday, October 5, 2014. Barbara was born on January 16, 1929, to the late Henry Newton Carver and Mary Lou "Uddy" (Wood). In addition to her parents she is preceded in death by her brothers, Henry Newton Carver, Jr., Max M.
