Beatrice Tanner Rose died on April 19, 2009 at Rockdale Medical Center as a result of complications related to Alzheimer's disease. Known to all as "Bea" Mrs. Rose was born January 7, 1923 in Hoschton and was the daughter of the late Dillard Butler and Omie Grier Tanner.
