



## Betty F. Ammerman

February 20, 1944 - July 23, 2010

Betty Houston Ammerman, 66, died at her home on Friday, July 23, 2010, surrounded by her beloved family, friends and three special care-givers, Marisela Hernandez, Belinda Chambers and Barbara Atkinson. Betty was a 'Crew Scheduler' with Eastern and remained there until operations ended in 1991. Betty then joined Newnan Hospital until her retirement in 2004.
