



Buvenia Steele

April 21, 1916 - July 27, 2009

Buvenia Warren Steele, 93, of Newnan, died Monday, July 27, 2009.

Mrs. Steele spent her entire adult life in Newnan and was the oldest living member of Arnco Baptist Church, which she attended for 70 years.

She was born in Roopville, Ga., on April 21, 1916, the daughter of John and Evie Hogan Warren. She grew up in Heard County in a farming family and attended grade school at Tyus. She was preceded in death by her husband, Lewis Steele; a brother, J.B. Warren; and a son, Stan Steele.

Mrs. Steele worked at Arnco Mill for 45 years, retiring at age 65. She re-entered the workforce for another seven years at Clover Electronics, retired a second time, then started a third career as a receptionist at Stan Steele Surveying, her son's business.

Survivors include daughter Emily Craft and husband Don of Huntsville, AL; son Doyle Steele and wife Harriet of Newnan; daughter Pam Beavers and husband Jimmy of Newnan and daughter-in-law Paula Steele of Newnan. She also is survived by eight grandchildren: Lee Craft of Nashville, Tenn.; Carrie Beavers Markham of Atlanta; Joe Craft of Chino Hills, Calif.; Jim Craft of Madison, AL; Adam Steele, of Newnan; Laura Steele Ball of Clarksville, Tenn.; Lewis and Sawyer Steele, both of Newnan, and a great-grandson, Davis Markham of Atlanta.
