Carl Hoffman, 91 of Newnan, GA stepped into heaven on Saturday, June 25, 2022, while in hospice at the home of Dave & Alice Hoffman.

Carl was born August 25th, 1930, in Midland Park, New Jersey. After high school, he worked in construction and later served in the United States Army in Europe. After returning to the United States, he married his high school sweetheart, Arlene Weimar. They owned and operated a small business, Carlene Home Construction, and later Hoffman Plumbing & Heating but their passion was serving the Lord by helping and encouraging people in their faith with God.

Carl was a member of the Hawthorne Gospel Church in Hawthorne, NJ, and served in various roles including Boys Brigade, middle school Sunday School teacher and youth ministry. He is a founding member of Operation Mobilization "OM" for over sixty years praying and caring for many missionaries. Carl also went on short-term missionary service trips with OM in East Africa, India, parts of Europe and on OM's ship Doulos and Logos II and with African Inland Mission (AIM) in Kenya.

After his retirement, Carl and Arlene moved to Sharpsburg, GA, and they both continued to volunteer in the OM US office. He was preceded in death by his loving wife Arlene.

He is survived by his sons, Carl, Brian, Greg, and Dave, eleven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren. He will be dearly missed.
