



## Carl Eugene Hogan

June 4, 1957 - February 15, 2023

Carl Eugene Hogan, age 65, passed away suddenly at his home in Newnan, GA on February 15, 2023.

Born in Bayshore, NY, Carl was a life-long sportsman, passionately enjoying both hunting and fishing. His enthusiasm for both took him from Alaska to the Gulf of Mexico and the Outer Banks of North Carolina. He served his country proudly in the U.S. Army and was a Gulf War Veteran.
