September 6, 1928 - December 10, 2013

Mr. Carl C. Wicker, 85, of Newnan passed away Tuesday, December 10, 2013 at Emory University Hospital. He was born September 6, 1928 in Montezuma, GA to the late Watson Wicker & Odessa Cook Wicker.

Mr. Wicker grew up in Jasper County, GA and graduated from the Pharmacy School at the University of Georgia. He moved to Newnan in 1955 to continue his pharmacy career at Joiner Drugstore and later worked at Jacobs Drugstore and retired from Revco.
