



Carol Hinshaw Dallas

August 8, 1940 - January 1, 2018

Carol Hinshaw Dallas, 77, of Senoia, died January 1, 2018 at Piedmont Hospital in Atlanta.

She will be remembered for her kindness. She was a devoted mother and grandmother, loyal friend, an animal lover, and a teacher who never forgot a single child she taught. She had great strength, surviving cancer three times and continuing to live life to the fullest. She loved traveling, volunteering at the Senoia Area Historical Society Museum, going on church mission trips, learning a new language, practicing calligraphy, flower gardening, spending time with friends and her dog, Sadie, and playing with her three granddaughters.

Born in Greensboro, NC, she was a daughter of the late Jesse Rez and Nettie Yvonne Davis Hinshaw. Mrs. Dallas taught at Eastside Elementary for many years and was a member of the Senoia Area Historical Society and the Grantville Senior Center.

She was a member of Senoia United Methodist Church where she performed in the Bell Choir.

Mrs. Dallas was preceded in death by her husband of fifty-seven years, Victor Wyatt Dallas, Jr.

Survivors include two daughters, Jennifer Dallas and husband Chris Young of Matthews, NC and Elisa Dallas and husband Jeff Shelby of Senoia; three grandchildren, Isabella Young, Sophia Young and Pearl Shelby; a brother, David Hinshaw and wife Faye of Charlotte; and several nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be conducted Sunday, February 4, 2018 at 1:00 PM at Senoia United Methodist Church with Reverend Ashley Jenkins officiating.
