



## Carol Fisher

September 26, 1927 - March 22, 2003

Mrs. Carol Edwards Fisher, 75, of Newnan, died Saturday, March 22, 2003, at Newnan Hospital East, following a brief illness.

Mrs. Fisher was born Sept. 26, 1927, in Coriopolis, Pa., the fifth child of Edith Hitchcock Edwards and Vere Buckingham Edwards. She attended the Winchester Thurston School for Girls, and graduated from Pembroke College of Brown University in 1950. While attending the Katherine Gibbs School in New York City, she met Jett Miller Fisher of Newnan. They were married Aug. 14, 1954, in Sewickly, Pa.

After moving to Newnan, she volunteered with several organizations and served as president of the Newnan Junior Service League, the Newnan Hospital Auxiliary, the Driftwood Garden Club, and the Parent's Club at The Heritage School. After her husband's death in 1975, she worked for three years at Newnan Hospital before becoming a caseworker with the Newnan Coweta Department of Family and Children Services. She retired in Dec. 2002.

Mrs. Fisher was preceded in death by her husband Jett and three infant sons. She was a member of Central Baptist Church.

A funeral will be held Tuesday, March 25, 2003, at 11 a.m. at Central Baptist

Church. Dr. Joel Richardson will officiate and burial will be in the Presbyterian section of Oak Hill Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers will be Ben Parham, Richard Click, Marcus Seitz, Cliff Cranford, Scott Wilson, Spud Williams, and Bill Litchfield
