Ms. Carole Murphy Busby, 90, of Newnan passed away Saturday, October 26, at home surrounded by her family, including her dogs. She was born March 06, 1934 in Rome, Georgia to the late Andrew Buford Murphy and Elizabeth Murphy Plumb. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her daughter, Martha Elizabeth (Beth) Davidson and brother Charles Berry Murphy.

Raised in Rome, Georgia, Ms. Busby was employed by the Federal Government for 30 years, lastly as a paralegal with the SEC.
