February 18, 1949 - December 25, 2022

Mrs. Carroll Harwood Clason (Darden), age 73, of Newnan, formerly of Elkins, WV; Riverside, CA; and Fredericksburg, VA; passed away on Christmas Day, 2022. Carroll was born on February 18, 1949, in Elkins to the late George and Norma Darden. She was preceded in death by her brother Jim.

Carroll was affectionally known to her grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and others as Nanny. She was a graduate of Elkins High School, class of 1967. After high school, she moved to Savannah, GA. Through a mutual friend, she met her future husband, Wayne Clason, in 1970. Wayne was in the U.S. Army and had recently returned from service in Vietnam. Their first date was at a drive-in movie, and they were married in May 1970.

Carroll was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother. She worked as an insurance claims adjustor for many years at Geico in Fredericksburg, VA. A consummate cook, she was known for her Christmas cookies and scalloped potatoes, recipes she was rumored to have passed down from her own mother. She never met a stranger and would carry on a conversation with anyone. Carroll loved football, and many weekends in the fall one could find her rooting for the West Virginia Mountaineers or one of her various "favorite" NFL teams (of which she had several). Her last evening alive was spent loving on her two great-grandchildren.

Sowers; brothers Thomas Darden and Robert Darden; grandchildren, David, Justin, Brandie, Zackary, Chelsea, and Jimmy; and great-grandchildren Brooks and Maelynn.

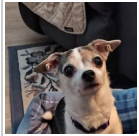
