Cecil "Joe" Howard Adams died peacefully at home surrounded by family and friends on July 26th, 2024 at his home in Newnan, GA. He was born to Ernest and Lois Adams on July 5, 1941 in Atlanta Georgia. He is preceded in death by his father Ernest Adams, mother Lois Adams, brother Carl Wesley Adams and sister Mary Adams. He was the church custodian as well as worked on the grounds committee for his church. Joe loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them. He was known for his whistling, making

people laugh, wanting to borrow a twenty-dollar bill and be the "protector of purses and diamond rings." He never met a stranger and he loved helping people. He was dependable. He enjoyed detailing cars and would always say, "if it don't shine, it ain't mine". His granddaughters, jokingly, were always fighting to be his favorite, saying "call me by name, pawpaw." He took pride in his homeplace, and enjoyed working in the yard. One of his favorite past time hobbies was sitting around the house, picking his guitar, and singing with his girls. Joe was known to load the truck with his guitar, family, and friends, and head to the nursing home to play for the residents, as well as sing and play for other churches during revivals.

Some comments by some of the ones that loved him: "His whistle made me smile", "I always felt safe when I heard him whistle", "God didn't make but one Joe, and He did it with greatness", "I always enjoyed his many jokes and quick wit", "He always gave the biggest hugs."

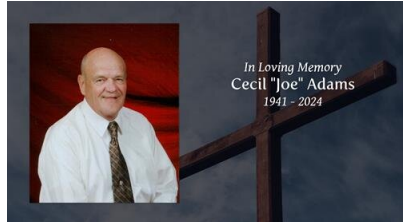
