Charles Thomas "CT" White, age 76, passed away peacefully at his home in Union City, Georgia, on April 20, 2025.

Mr. White was born in Atlanta, Georgia on August 11, 1948. He was preceded in death by his wonderful parents, the late Charles Bolton White and Dorothy Shattles White of Jonesboro, Georgia. He was known to his family as "Tommy" and to his many friends as "CT", and had the honor of being "Papaw" to his grandchildren.

He attended Jonesboro High School before joining the U.S. Navy. He served his country from 1965 - 1985. His many stations of deployment were the Philippines, Sicily, Italy, Jacksonville, Florida, Patuxent River NAS, Maryland and Pt.Mugu, California. He had the distinct honor of never having served aboard a ship during his 20 years of deployment. After his retirement from the Navy, he was employed by Safety Signal, Union City, Ga.
