Mr. Charles Franklin Jones, Jr., 78, of Newnan passed away Monday, November 23, 2015 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. Mr. Charlie was born December 27, 1936 in Atlanta, GA to the late Charles F. Jones & Ethel Elizabeth Easton Jones.

Mr. Charlie was a longtime member of Cornerstone United Methodist Church. He was a patriotic veteran who served his country in the Air Force. 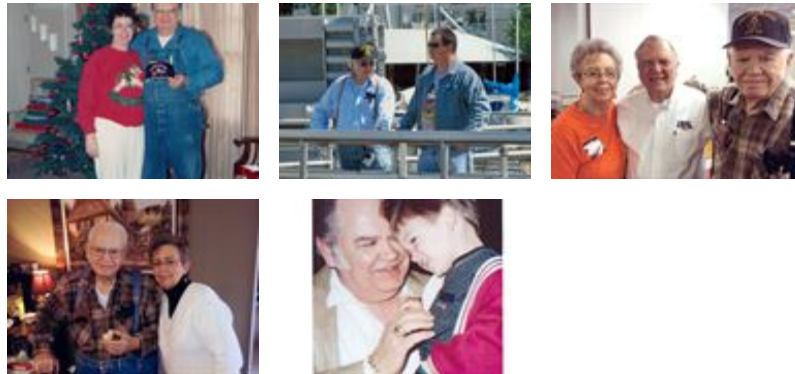
