Charles Alan Lashley, age 53, died January 2nd after a brief illness at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. Alan was born May 31, 1962 in Shreveport, Louisiana and was one of two children born to the late Charles E. and Whittie Jordan Lashley. Alan was a man who loved the outdoors. Hunting was a big part of his life. NASCAR was another passion, but nothing more so than his devotion as an Alabama fan. He spent 35 years in service to his company as an assembly coordinator. Alan is survived by his devoted wife Lisa McKoy Lashley; his children Luci Danielle Presley and Jeremy Andrew (Kristin) Presley. 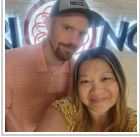

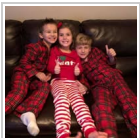
