His love for animals was just as deep. He shared an unbreakable bond with his beloved dog, Cloe, whose memory stayed close to his heart, and he dearly adored his cat, Carti, who misses him every day.

Chris is lovingly remembered by his parents, Michael and Loretta Johnson; his grandfather, William Johnson; and his grandparents, Edwardo and Norma Zapata. He is also held close in the hearts of his longtime girlfriend, Caren, and their cherished cat, Cartier "Carti."
