Chris Landreau, 27, of Newnan passed away Tuesday, June 14, 2011 at Emory University Hospital, surrounded by his family, friends, and brotherhood of Fire Fighters. He was born March 27, 1984 in Tifton, GA. He graduated from Newnan High School in 2002 and married the love of his life, Amanda Montour Landreau, on November 26, 2003.

Chris was a Fire Fighter with the Coweta County Fire Department, Station One, where he was on the Rescue One team. In addition to being a Fire Fighter, Chris was a loving husband, father, son, brother, friend, and Youth Minister at Providence Baptist Church in the Welcome Community.

The funeral is Friday, June 17, 2011 at 11:00 am at the First Baptist Church of Newnan, 15 West Washington St., Newnan with Rev. Ken Norton officiating. Burial will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Park in Newnan. The visitation is Thursday evening between 5:00-8:00 at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan, GA.
