Christopher Robert Lanyi (Chris), age 63 of Moreland, Georgia, passed away on Friday, September 19, 2025, at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born on January 30, 1962 to Richard J. Lanyi and Sarah Sage Lanyi in Cleveland, Ohio. He was a graduate of George Walton Comprehensive High School in Marietta, Georgia. Chris went on to graduate with an Agriculture Degree and teaching certificate from the University of Georgia in Athens. Chris was a science teacher, served as coach for Newnan High School Girls lacrosse team and a time keeper for the basketball teams.
