



Clarence Wesley Iverson, Jr.

November 25, 1936 - March 24, 2025

Mr. Clarence W. Iverson Jr., 88, of Newnan, passed away Monday, March 24, 2025, at Piedmont Newnan Hospital. He was born November 25, 1936, in Plattville, WI, to the late Clarence Iverson Sr. & Mary Cardy Iverson Lange. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by daughter, Dona Iverson McDonald and Son & Law, Gary McDonald, 1 Sister (Mary Anne), and 2 brothers, Ray and Jack Iverson.

In July 1958, he married the love of his life, Geraldine (Eloise) Iverson, after a whirlwind romance, and they shared almost 67 wonderful years together.
