



## Clarence Wells Jackson, Jr.

May 8, 1925 - August 8, 2018

Mr. Clarence Wells Jackson, Jr., 93 of Newnan, GA, passed away August 8, 2018 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital after a sudden illness. He was born May 8, 1925 in Ashburn, Georgia, to the late Clarence W. Jackson and Corinne Betts Jackson.

Clarence served in the Pacific in the US Navy during World War II. At the end of the War, Clarence returned to Georgia where he met his wife of 70 years, Jeannine Taylor Jackson, in Newnan. After a 2 year courtship the two married in 1948. The couple grew their family and welcomed 3 sons, Wayne, Alan and David, over the next 10 years while Clarence started his own business which he managed until his retirement in 1985.

Clarence served in various lay roles at Newnan Presbyterian Church over 65 years where he and his family enjoyed membership. During retirement Clarence could most often be found working in his yard and garden, playing golf with friends, and enjoying his ever growing family. Clarence and Jeannine were blessed with 3 sons, 8 grandchildren, 9 great grandchildren (and counting). Family and close friends are the treasure of life, and Clarence was indeed a wealthy man.

A public memorial service officiated by Reverend David Jones will be held at Newnan Presbyterian Church on Saturday, August 11, 2018 at 2:00 pm and be followed by a brief reception in the Church's Fellowship Hall. The Church is located at 38 Greenville Street, Newnan, Georgia. A private family graveside service will be held at Forest Lawn Memorial Park on August 11, 2018.
