Clinton Huling, 77, was born on August 30, 1943 to the late Leonard Huling, Jr. and Ophelia Partridge in Newnan, Georgia. Clinton grew up in the Roscoe and Northside Communities, and received his education in the Coweta County School System. He was a member of the Oak Grove Baptist Church.

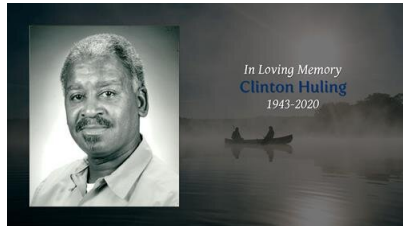
