In addition to his parents, he was predeceased by his sister Syble Pettigrew. His love for his country led him to enlist in the United States Navy in 1954. He was honorably discharged in 1958. Clyde was a man for whom problem solving seemed a gift. This was a valuable asset in his career as a building contractor. He was just as at home with carpentry tools in his hands as he was in the driver's seat of earth moving equipment. Many construction projects in Coweta County benefitted from his considerable skill set. A natural outdoorsman, he found great pleasure in his bird dogs and his bee hives. 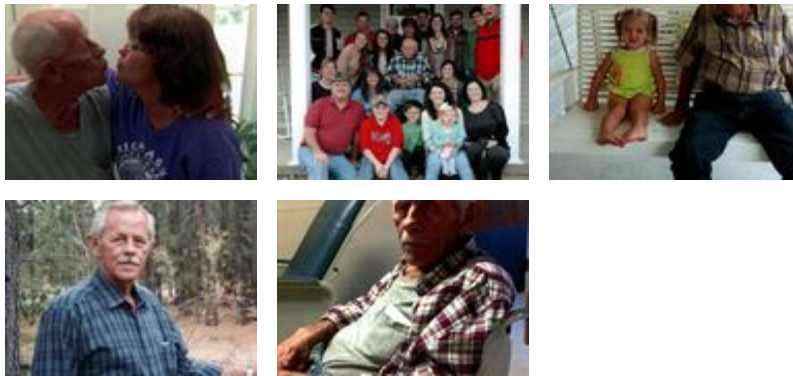
