



Curtis Excell Ivey

May 19, 1918 - February 14, 2013

Mr. Curtis E. Ivey, 94, of Newnan died Thursday, February 14, 2013 at Brightmoor Hospice in Griffin. He was born May 19, 1918 in Forsyth, GA to the late James Troy Ivey & Addie Mae Lynch Ivey.

Mr. Ivey was a longtime member and deacon of Trinity Baptist Church in Newnan. He served in the Army, Company A-255th Engineer Combat Battallion during WWII. He received several decorations & citations, including European African Middle Eastern Theater Ribbon with 2 Bronze Stars. After his honorable discharge from the Army, Mr. Ivey worked for Georgia Power for many years at Plant Yates, retiring after 33 years. He also served as a Georgia Power Ambassador.

The funeral is Saturday, February 16, 2013 at 11:00 a.m. in the chapel of McKoon Funeral Home with Rev. Rick Duncan officiating. Burial will be at Forest Lawn Memorial Park. The visitation is Saturday morning from 10:00 a.m. until service time at the funeral home.
