“*My Brother Dave, May 10 2010 I have so many thoughts about my brother Dave, I thought I would have the time, I thought that time would be years in which I would have been able to make sure I had shared with him all of my thoughts, and feelings about all that he brought to me and others. I wish that was so. Some thoughts, memories and appreciation: Until we were 10-12 years old, Dave and Ted and I shared our bedroom. Dave was in charge, we had to follow the rules (Dave’s rules!), and we had truly the best time being brothers. We went into the woods, we fished, caught turtles, snakes, salamanders, if it walked, crawled, swam or flew—we wanted to get our hands on it. Dave’s great passion was the outdoors, and we loved it with him, because he was our older brother. Dave brought that same passion to his sons, whenever I visited I remembered seeing him sharing the same experiences with his sons, he loved it so much. His enthusiasm was contagious. His enjoyment of the outdoors and critters was a big deal in his life. I remember when he was preparing to go off to the army, something Ted and I did not understand, Dave was 16, I think. What we did understand on the day before he left, was that he took Ted and me to the zoo at Forest Park to spend time with us, I think we must have been 11-12 years old...little boys who he knew would miss their big brother, he wanted us to know how much he cared about us. I remember when Dave and Maria were married....like yesterday. I remember watching and appreciating from afar how their relationship grew and became so rich with the birth of their sons. The sons were Dave’s treasure, which he was tremendously modest about, but so deeply proud. Brian, Tim, and Davy became the product of Maria and Dave. The rest of the family has observed over the years, with some degree of wonderment on my part, the outcome of Maria and Dave’s marriage....the boys. The respect, the polite behavior, the development of their faith, the “do the right thing attitude”, their academics. Dave will live on in Brian and Tim and Davy. Dave and I had developed our relationship quite significantly over the years; he became for me a critical and important source of guidance over these past 10 years, especially after the passing of our father. Dave helped me in the development of my faith on a frequent basis. He*

*helped me through some incredibly trying times, and some joyous ones. Dave touched me in so many ways; my life and the lives of others were changed and made better by Dave's involvement in our lives. How fortunate all of us are to have had Dave in our lives. I cannot express how much I will miss my brother, nor how clearly I know I will remember and use all he taught me during his life. As recently as this spring he helped me learn about my faith in a way that has changed my approach to life, and the lives of my family. On this day, and every day I will pray for Dave, remember all his works. He will live on in us.*
