David Farrell Scogin's faith became sight Sunday morning, February 28, 2010, after a valiant battle with cancer. He was born May 11, 1948 in College Park to Ethel Elizabeth Hendrix Scogin & the late Otis Farrell Scogin of Fayetteville.

He attended and was a loyal fan of Auburn University and was a graduate of Georgia State University. He served his country in the U.S. Marine Reserves.

David was a veteran of the banking industry in Georgia for over 40 years. His expertise in helping start many community banks gave him the opportunity to live in many towns around the state. He was instrumental in the formation of First Coweta Bank, First National Bank of the South in Milledgeville, and Carrollton State Bank. David also worked at Trust Company Bank in Jonesboro, C&S Bank, and other banks in the Atlanta area.

He was active in the Newnan community where he was a Member of Macedonia Baptist Church and the Newnan Kiwanis Club. He was a past member and deacon of the First Baptist Church of Milledgeville & First Baptist Church of Carrollton, a member of First Baptist Church of Jonesboro, First Baptist Church of College Park. He was a previous member of the Kiwanis club of Carrollton, and the Rotary Club of Milledgeville.

The funeral is Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 2:00 pm at Macedonia Baptist

Church, 1504 Macedonia Rd, Newnan, GA with Rev. John Riley officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery. The visitation is Monday evening between 5:00 – 8:00 pm at McKoon Funeral Home, 38 Jackson St, Newnan, GA.
