



## David Glenn Trippe

November 27, 1951 - May 28, 2023

Mr. David "Glenn" Trippe, 71, of Riverdale Georgia, passed away peacefully on May 28, 2023 surrounded by family and friends in the home of his daughter, Kellie Willis in Newnan, GA.
