Deborah Elaine "Debbie" Sibley passed away on Saturday, February 14, 2026. Debbie was born on June 7, 1952, to the late John and Martha Sibley. In her early years, Debbie attended Moreland Elementary and graduated from Newnan High School. She furthered her career at GA Baptist School of Nursing, gaining her Nursing degree. And attending the Medical College of Georgia, earning her BSN and MNS diplomas. Debbie dedicated 47 years as a registered nurse, employed by Newnan Hospital, University Hospital in Augusta, GA; the Medical College of Georgia in Macon, GA; and the OB/GYN for the State of Georgia.

Ms. Debbie professed her faith in the Lord Jesus Christ as her savior and became a member of White Oak Presbyterian Church at a young age.
