



Delmar Deneen Reynolds

October 1, 1940 - October 16, 2023

Mr. Delmar Deneen Reynolds, 83, a resident of Newnan, GA, and formerly of Alton, IL, peacefully passed away on Monday, October 16th, 2023, at Insignia of Newnan - Assisted Living and Memory Care, surrounded by his family.

Born in Harrisburg, IL, on October 1, 1940, to the late Calvin James Reynolds and Virginia Rose Owens Reynolds Battles (Raleigh Battles), Delmar was preceded in death by his loving wife of 54 years, Carol Jean Zerow Reynolds, and his beloved wife, Ann Poe Reynolds. Delmar was a dedicated member of Sharpsburg Baptist Church, where he served as a Deacon, actively participating in the Kitchen Ministry alongside both Carol and Miss Ann.
