January 7, 1948 - November 11, 2022

Donna Rae Krach passed away peacefully November 11, 2022 after a three-month illness. She was born January 7, 1948 in Clarksburg, West Virginia. The eldest child of Frank M. Davis (1920-1978) and Rachael J. Davis (née Wolfe, 1923-2022), she set a trailblazing example for her three sisters to make their own way with her humor, stubborn will, and compassion.

She graduated from Triadelphia High School in Wheeling, West Virginia in 1965. From there she attended West Virginia University, where she was a member of the history honorary and Phi Beta Kappa. At WVU she met her future husband, Dale James Krach (1947-2012). She graduated from WVU with high honors in 1969 and the next year, married Dale. They would have three children over the next decade. Both would remain proud Mountaineers all their lives.

A voracious reader and student of history, Donna was a natural teacher. She would be employed by the Coweta County Board of Education for 22 years, teaching social studies to generations of children at both Central Middle School and Smokey Road Middle School in Newnan, Georgia. She retired in 2008.

Donna is much missed by her sons Josh (wife Kathleen) and Nathan Krach and her daughter Amy Krach-Caston (wife Crystal); granddaughters Svea

Krach and Lennox Caston; and beloved sisters Susan Stumpp (husband King), Barbi J. Davis and Paula Coleman.
