Dorothy Ellen Bryan, 81, of Newnan went to be with Our Lord on Wednesday April 30, 2025, at Corinth Road Assisted Living. Ellen grew up in Senoia, GA and was a 1961 graduate of East Coweta High School. Ellen worked in several different places around Newnan such as Coweta General Hospital, William L. It was in that position that she met so many people as they came for permits. Still to this day people all over Middle GA say I met Ellen years ago when I was working on this project or that project. She made people feel very comfortable in most cases. She always had pictures of her 4 boys on her desk and we were told she spent a lot of time bragging on us. Several people over the years have said they felt like they knew us, but we had never met. Ellen was a longtime member of what was then Digby Assembly of God church at Brooks, GA.

The funeral is Monday May 5, 2025, at 2:00 at the Chapel of McKoon Funeral Home in Newnan GA, with Pastor Tim Hammett officiating. Burial will follow at Forest Lawn Memorial Park in Newnan. The visitation will be on Monday May

“ I was sorry to hear Mrs. Ellen had passed away. We worked together in the early 1980s at the City of Newnan, Building Department. She was invaluable source of information about Newnan, building and zoning as well as random information that floated around town. She was quite a conversationalist and would talk at length to contractors that would come in the office.

At the time I was the youngest member of a five-person department and not much older than her own children. Some of the places we had to go around town was not the safest and she kept a tight tether. I could hear her now calling me on the truck radio (before cell phones) 94 what is your 20 or in other words, where are you? I could go on with funny things that happen during that era such as the time she could not find me and sent the Police Department to locate me which they did.

We shared many lunches together as she would send me to Sprayberrys to buy lunch. I always thought a lot of her - Cindy and I got married while i worked there and she served in our wedding. Even after I left the City I would call her with random questions and she was always gracious and if we did see each other out around town our conversation started with a hug.

I knew she was a good Christian lady by the tone of her conversation and as she often talked about her church.
