



Dr. William O'Neal Elliott

March 8, 1921 - July 15, 2006

Dr. W.O. Elliott, 85, died July 15, 2006, while sleeping in the peace of his home.

A native of Crenshaw County, Ala., he was born March 8, 1921, to the late William P. and Zora Cochran Elliott. Upon his graduation from Logan Chiropractic College in St. Louis, Mo., in 1949, he moved to Newnan.

Dr. Elliott was a veteran of World War II, having served in the Army Medical Corps. His involvement in his community included service as a Mason, a member of Shrine, and he was a charter member of the Newnan Elk's Lodge.
