Edith Rose Clark Pentecost passed away at home July 14, 2015. She was born October 13, 1923 in Trafford, West Moreland County, Pennsylvania at the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains. She was preceded in death by her husband of over 62 years, William Walter (Bill) Pentecost.

Her working life began as a book-keeper, but she soon became a house wife and stay-at-home mom when she met Bill after World War II. She lived in Dallas, Texas for her entire married life. Possessing a vivid imagination, a dramatic flair, and a way with words, she was an entertaining story teller. Using the name Pat while she was married, she began writing while her children were still at home, then devoted all her time to it after they had left to be on their own. Several of her plays were produced locally in the Dallas and Lake Whitney area. She even had a one act play off Broadway for a week and received a Kennedy Center award for playwriting. She continued to write professionally through her mid 80's.

When Bill died in 2009, she moved to Georgia to live with one of her daughters. She is survived by her daughters: Margaret Rose (Meg) Shehad and Johnna Clark Freuler along with their partners Lou Vaughn and Tony Freuler, her granddaughters: Sarah Meseberg and Amy Findley with husband Craig, and one great granddaughter Ava Rose Findley.
