Edward Franklin Kirbow, 83, of Senoia died Tuesday, October 20, 2009. He was born February 11, 1926 in Milner, GA to the late H. Clinton & Ione Crawford Kirbow.

Frank spent much of his adult life as a 4-H volunteer, dedicating weekends and evenings to the enrichment of the lives of youth. He often stated, "I am more interested in teaching youth how to become winners than good losers." His sense of humor, friendship, and ability to motivate a winning attitude in youth yielded many state winners. He served as an air traffic controller in the Army from 1946 to 1949 and was an active member of White Oak Associate Reformed Presbyterian Church.
