Elizabeth JoAnne (Beth) Spradlin Pitts, 67, of Newnan, passed away on June 26 at Piedmont Newnan Hospital, surrounded by close, lifelong friends and family. Beth was born on July 3, 1957, to Eddie Harold Spradlin and Joan Robison Spradlin. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, James Durwood Pitts Jr. She is survived by her sister Nancy Spradlin, her beloved dog, Abbie Grace, and many dear friends.

Beth grew up in Newnan and attended Atkinson Elementary School, Newnan Jr High School, and graduated from Newnan High School with the Class of 1975. After high school, she attended North Georgia College, where she was a member of the Phi Mu fraternity, and graduated with a bachelor's degree in 1979. She later attended Georgia State University and the University of Georgia, obtaining her master's degree in education. Beth was a lifelong educator and loved all her high school students, making many lifelong friends. She taught at Cass High School in Cartersville, GA, North Hall High School in Gainesville, Woodville-Tompkins High School in Savannah, and, at the time of her death, as a substitute teacher for the Coweta County School System. She held many positions with DECA on both the local, state, and national levels.

Beth loved her North Ga College and has held several positions with the board of directors and alumni association since graduation.
