



Elizabeth Jenkins Landrum

November 11, 1949 - July 27, 2024

Elizabeth "Beanie" Jenkins Landrum, of Columbus, Georgia, and recently of Malden, Massachusetts, died of lifelong complications resulting from major depression and an eating disorder. She was a breast cancer survivor for over 14 years.

Born Margaret Elizabeth Jenkins on November 11, 1949, Elizabeth loved to sing, loved Jesus, and believed strongly in women's humanity and dignity before God. She graduated from Tift College in 1971 where she served as class president her sophomore year and was a proud member of the Tift Cutie Pies. Elizabeth had four careers including English teacher; Delta Airlines administrative professional; wife, mother, supercommuter, and homemaker; and pharmacy technician for Publix Supermarkets, the last for nearly 20 years.

She is survived by three children: Dr. Shane R. Landrum of Malden, Massachusetts; Ms. Susan Landrum Swain of Brisbane, Australia, and Mrs. Joanna Landrum Pummer of Newnan, Georgia; four grandchildren: Mariah Landrum, Titus Pummer, Micah Landrum, and Jack Swain; and a brother, Mr. Robert Andrew Jenkins, and his three children, Jacqueline, Elizabeth, and Ellen, along with their dear mother, Margaret. Elizabeth was preceded in death by her beloved brother William Lester Jenkins, in 1986, her parents, Dora Moore Jenkins and Charles Hampton Jenkins, in 2013, and her

cherished Aunt Mary "Me-Me" Mills in 2021.
