Elizabeth "Betty" McDonald Josephs, 81, of Newnan passed away Tuesday, November 1, 2016 at her home. Betty was born April 27, 1935 in Kingstree, South Carolina to the late Charles McDonald & Dorothy Rouse McDonald. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband of 38 years, Robert Arthur Josephs.

Betty grew up Kingstree, SC where she graduated from Kingstree High School. She attended Columbia College and College of Charleston. After college, she began her career as a flight attendant with Eastern Airlines. While working at Eastern, she fell in love and married a D.C. 9 Captain, Bob Josephs. In 1965, she and Bob moved to Newnan where they were instrumental in the establishment of the Coweta County Volunteer Fire Department. Betty was an accomplished artist and oil painter. She was an initial volunteer who worked with Tom Powers in establishing the Powers Crossroads Arts Festival. After Bob's death, Betty moved her church membership to Emory Chapel United Methodist Church.
