Mr. Eugene Amos Smith, 86, of Newnan passed away Saturday, October 31, 2015 at Roosevelt Warm Springs Institute. He was born August 20, 1929 in Newnan to the late Clarence Martin Smith & Lonnie Lou Hardegree Smith.
