



## Florence Lillian Teed

August 10, 1917 - August 19, 2015

Florence L. Teed, age 98, of Sharpsburg, Georgia, formerly of Middletown, New York, passed away Wednesday, August 19, 2015.

Mrs. Teed was born August 10, 1917 in Sussex County, New Jersey to the late Ernest and Mabel Wallace. She was married to the late Clarence Elston and later to Warner Teed. While married to Clarence, they lived and raised their four children in Middleton, New York. In Middletown, she worked as a Domestic Sales Clerk at Lloyds Super Market before it was destroyed by fire and was a faithful member of Trinity Assembly of God Church.
